Installation


To install the program, please follow the instructions below step by step:

- 1. Download and install Binge-Watching Player from Download Center.
- 2. Double click the installation package of Binge-Watching Player to start installing the program on your computer. Then simply drag the Binge-Watching Player application's icon to your Applications folder.
- 3. Follow the instructions to finish the installation.

Note: You can customize the output path for the program as well as create a desktop shortcut icon for convenience during the installation.


Main Interface

Menu


Click the "Menu" button on the upper-right corner, and you will see a dialogue as below:



How to Play Streaming Video


Step 1: Select Website

Open Binge-Watching Player on Mac, and select website that you want to play the videos from.



Step 2: Sign in with Streaming Services Account

Sign in with your Netflix, Prime Video or other streaming services' account and choose profile. If there is PIN code set in the profile, then you may also be asked to enter PIN code.



Step 3: Set Playback Settings

Please go to the Setting window to enable the options of "Prevent trailers for auto-playing", "Prevent hover effect on video posters", and more as needed.




Step 4: Browse and Play Video

Now, you can browse and choose a video, and start your watching time. During watching, you can click the Speed icon to speed up or slow down the playback speed, the PIP mode to minimize the player window, and the dialogue icon to change audio track and subtitles.



How to Check Play History

Open Binge-Watching Player on Mac, click "Menu". Then you can choose "History" in the drop-down list to view the play record and continue playing your last played video.




How to Set Video Quality


Step 1. Click the inverted triangle icon and then choose "Account".



Step 2. Scroll down and click the down arrow beside the profile you are using. Then find the option "Playback Setting" and hit "Change". Here you can also change the language, viewing restriction and more.



Step 3. Now you can select your desired video quality.
